We have officially started the second year academy. of the There are two kindergarteners, two 1st graders, and three 3rd graders. Curriculums for 3rd and K/1st have split this year, which means the two different **learning** groups are extracurriculars. 3rd grade is going more in-depth in their Bible studies as well as learning about mammals, Greek myths, and the states/capitols.

Week 1 K/1st grade learned about the tea plant and how there are different types of tea. They learned where in the world the tea plant is grown and what the different types of tea plants are used for. We visited The Spice & Tea Exchange to see firsthand the difference in tea and even got to try some herbal tea. We ended the field trip at a park where we had a picnic lunch and enjoyed the beautiful day. 3rd has started reading Farmer Boy and this week was mostly spent remembering what it means to be back at school.





Week 2, we visited Terra Sancta because it used to be a working monastery. The boys were blessed to have a tour led by one of the sisters who used to live and work there. They learned about St. Benedict and what daily life was like for the sisters. They were in awe about the size and grandeur of the church on campus. During the week, they read a book about ancient monks and how the monks transferred books like the Bible to "paper" for the average person to read. The students made "ink" using raspberries, vinegar, and salt. They were amazed that it actually worked and they were able to paint with it. 3rd grade started their Greek myth studies and also seem to enjoy learning about each individual state and where the state is located.

Week 3 has been one of the more memorable field trips. We had a tour of the Crazy Horse Memorial and the boys kept talking about how huge the carving is and will eventually be. They liked collecting rocks that have been blasted off the mountain as well as learning that there isn't one picture of Crazy Horse. The sculpture is based off his friends' descriptions of him. The art of the week for K/1st was View of Paris from Montmartre and in music the students have started singing songs from The Sound of Music.



Week 4 the boys went to the KOTA Territory News studio. They learned about the green screen and how to do the weather report. They got to sit where the news anchors sit during the news cast.







